get physically active (Physical Recreation)

develop interests and skills (Skills)

experience adventure (Expeditions)

and join a residential project (Gold Level only)

The 5 sections can be easily achieved

together with your school activities.

If you are not yet 14 years old,

Green Bird in Action can be your choice

because it is for young people ages 12 to 13.5.

After you have achieved the Award,

You will become more competitive in university admission

By enriching your “Other Learning Experience” or “Student Learning Profile”.

The Award is internationally recognized,

So you can continue your Award journey

if you study overseas by transferring your membership.

You will also have a chance to exchange overseas and

meet Award participants around the world.
