

Sponsored by Swire TrustTomorrow, The Hong Kong Award for Young People are going to co-organise a Skill Section activity called "Postcards from Planet Possible: The Workshop" with National Geographic Creative Works. The theme of the programme is Digital Arts and Marine Conversation. National Geographic Explorers and Local Artists from National Geographic would teach participants how to use creativity to explore important conservation issues in Hong Kong and develop deep connections with the nature. Also, participants would have a chance to engage in other workshops and field trips which are related to music and ecosystem. Details are as follows:

1. Objectives:

- To learn and explore marine conversation in Hong Kong;
- To learn how to use creativity to create impactful artworks;
- To broaden the horizon of the participants by exposing other side of Hong Kong

2. Duration: September 2022 – December 2022

3. Programme Fee:

Free of Charge (Applicants have to pay a deposit of HK\$300 which would be refunded after completing the programme.)

4. Number of Participants:

(Shortlisted Candidates will be invited to attend a selection on 20 September 2022 in the evening)

5. Qualification:

- AYP Participants (Silver and Gold Level participants have to fulfill the requirement of the Award Level by taking digital arts or marine conservation learning on your own.)
- > Be interested in marine conservation and art;
- ➤ Have a pleasant personality and willing to meet new friends

7. Remarks:

- Participants have to take part in selection on 20 September 2022;
 - The selection focuses on how passionate the applicant is towards the programme, instead of his/her ability on speaking English.
- Participants have to attend **ALL** workshops, fieldtrips and other designated activities;
- The medium of instruction would be in English and support with Cantonese;
- Participants have to responsible for your own meal and transportation expenses;
- Locations of all activities would be revealed later;
- Deposit would be refunded if;
 - Participants not be selected for the programme;
 - The programme is cancelled by the organizer.
- Applicants must notice the Award Office before application deadline if he/she chooses to withdraw the application. 20% of the deposit would be deducted for administration cost. The remaining deposit would be reimbursed by cheque. Request received after the application deadline would not be considered.

8. Precautions under COVID-19

- ➤ Under the pandemic, the programme would follow the instructions of 'Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation'. Activities may be postponed or canceled.
- Participants have to do Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) and obtain negative test result before attending each activity and send to AYP staff before the activity commences. Participant with positive test result or being identified as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case must not attend the activity and report to AYP staff immediately.
